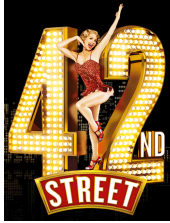

Getting into the Venue

The Theatre Royal Drury Lane main entrance is situated on Catherine Street. There are 6 steps up into the foyer from street level, through double doors. The steps are not clearly marked and there are no handrails. All sections of the theatre, other than the Stalls, must be reached via stairs as there is no customer lift.

Stalls

The Stalls have 20 steps down and a further 17 steps up from the main foyer. All steps in the Stalls are highlighted, but there is no customer lift.

Royal Circle

The Royal Circle is accessible via 39 steps up from the theatre foyer.
